Achieving these goals requires the commitment of the entire birthing community. Your hospital's participation is critical in protecting mothers and babies from preventable complications and mortality.

Meridian is committed to advancing equitable birthing outcomes. As a proud partner and supporter of MI AIM safety bundles, we are launching a Free Blood Pressure & WiFi-Enabled Tablet Initiative to strengthen hospital compliance and improve outcomes for the Severe Hypertension in Pregnancy Safety Bundle.

The initiative focuses on improving 3-day and 7-day post-discharge follow up visits for perinatal patients discharged after a hypertension-related hospitalization.

Participating hospitals will receive:

- **Omron blood pressure monitoring systems** to provide qualifying pregnant patients upon hospital discharge.
- **Wifi-enabled Android tablets** (as needed) to support telehealth access for follow-up care.

To qualify, hospitals must:

1. Be an in-network Meridian Health partner
2. Be fully committed to the MI AIM Severe Hypertension in Pregnancy Safety Bundle in 2025 and remain continuously committed through measurement year 2027.
3. Submit a completed application by the 2025 Deadline: December 31, 2025.
4. Follow all initiative guidelines and maintain compliance with both, MI AIM Safety Bundles and Meridian Health Plan requirements.
