Incorporating Diverse SOGIE Into Your Work Training

Dear Providers,

Sexual Orientation, Gender Identity, and Expression (SOGIE) trainings are back with an in-depth focus on how to collect SOGIE data in Systems of Care. Full content is delivered over a day and a half of training and divided into three sections, each three hours long. The same content in the three sections will be provided over a virtual learning platform at each set of dates. This event is free, but registration is required as capacity is limited.

Objectives:

- 1. Participants will understand the difference between assigned sex, gender identity, gender expression, and sexual orientation.
- 2. Participants will know how to ask about SOGIE using a trauma-informed approach.
- 3. Participants will understand why SOGIE (statistics, evidence-based practices, personal narratives) are important to discuss when moving through systems of care.

Continuing Education (CE) credits are provided for nurses and social workers at a maximum of 8.5 CE credits for those who complete all three sessions. Registrants have a choice of taking all three courses or just one or two to earn CEs. Certificates of attendance for other health care professionals will also be provided upon request. Please allow 45 days to receive your CE certificate from MPHI. Registrants not seeking credits will have the option of taking courses in different months, but it is highly encouraged that the trainings be completed together.
