Meridian (Medicaid) Updates

Preferred Diabetic Test Strips and Glucometer Changes (Effective 10/1/2025)

Meridian would like to inform all prescribers and pharmacies that the **coverage** of preferred blood glucose test strips is changing for all Michigan Meridian Medicaid members.

Effective 10/01/2025, OneTouch Verio Blood Glucose Test Strips will be removed from the formulary (list of covered medications). Starting on 07/07/2025, Accu-Chek Guide Test Strips and Glucometers have been co-preferred with OneTouch Verio Test Strips, enabling product transition for Michigan Meridian Medicaid members to move from OneTouch Verio to Accu-Chek Guide products.

Starting on 10/01/2025, the only preferred blood glucose test strips and glucometers will be Accu-Chek Guide Test Strips, along with Accu-Chek Guide and Guide Me glucometers. This applies under the pharmacy benefit only for Michigan Meridian Medicaid members. Important Prior Authorization Requirement Updates

Effective October 15, 2025, Meridian is introducing some important updates to our PA requirements. This work is aligned with broader industry efforts, driven by commitments to regulatory agencies and America's Health Insurance Plans (AHIP), to modernize and streamline prior authorization. These changes may include:

- Removing PA requirements based on criticality of review and clinical need.
- Creating a more uniform set of prior authorization requirements across our markets and lines of businesses, including adding and changing some PA requirements, to simplify processes, reduce confusion for providers, and support future efforts to expand real-time responses to requests.

In addition, effective October 30, 2025, Meridian will require prior authorization for several skin substitute billing codes. Please refer to our bulletins page for a full list of affected codes for both initiatives.



National Childhood Obesity Awareness Month

- The coverage of certain insulin syringes and pen needle products is changing on 08/01/2025 for all members. Effective on 08/01/2025, insulin syringes and pen needles other than Embecta (formerly known as B.D.) branded products will be removed from the formulary.
