Meridian (Medicaid) Updates

Soft Launch of Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) for Medicaid Managed Care Home Health Care Services (HHCS) Ending December 31, 2025

On January 1, 2026, MDHHS will implement a hard cutover to EVV for managed care HHCS codes requiring EVV. The hard cutover applies to all Dates of Service on or after September 3, 2024. At hard cutover, these EVV services must be billed through the state's EVV system only. Prior Authorization Update: Behavioral Health Visit Limits

Effective January 1, 2026, Meridian Health Plan of Michigan will implement a **prior authorization (PA)** requirement for behavioral health services after a member's **24**th visit within a benefit period. This change aligns with Meridian's ongoing commitment to ensure members receive appropriate, clinically necessary care while supporting high-quality outcomes. MI AIM Severe Hypertension Bundle Initiative

The Michigan Alliance for Innovation on Maternal Health (MI AIM) equips hospitals with standardized best practices to **ensure safe births, improve prenatal and postpartum outcomes, and save lives**. Achieving these goals requires the commitment of the entire birthing community. Your hospital's participation is critical in protecting mothers and babies from preventable complications and mortality.

Meridian is committed to **advancing equitable birthing outcomes**. As a proud partner and supporter of MI AIM safety bundles, **later this fall we will be launching a Free Blood Pressure & WiFi-Enabled Tablet Initiative** to strengthen hospital compliance and improve outcomes for the **Severe Hypertension in Pregnancy Safety Bundle**. The initiative focuses on improving 3-day and 7-day post-discharge follow up visits for perinatal patients discharged after a hypertension-related hospitalization. Updated Prior Authorization Response Time Requirements

On January 1, 2026, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) will implement new prior authorization response time requirements for all providers.

- **Standard prior authorization requests** will be completed **within 7 calendar days**, with a possible extension up to 14 calendar days under certain circumstances.
- Expedited/Urgent prior authorization requests will be completed within 3 calendar days of receipt of the request.

Introducing the Health Insurance Portal App for Members

Meridian is launching a **mobile app for Member Portal access**. Members can **update their Primary Care Provider, view their benefits, and access their Meridian Member ID cards from their smartphone** on iOS and Android. Simply search the applicable app store for "Health Insurance Portal," to download the app.

Biosimilar Recommendations to Michigan Meridian Medicaid Prescribers

Providers are encouraged to adjust their prescribing practice for MI Medicaid beneficiaries to utilize the newly preferred biosimilar product adalimumab-adbm (unbranded Cyltezo) in place of brand name Humira, as well as biosimilars Pyzchiva (ustekinumab-ttwe) or Steqeyma (ustekinumab-stba) for patients newly starting therapy with adalimumab, effective on 11/01/2025. Providers should consider converting their patients who are already established on brand name Humira to the biosimilar product adalimumab-adbm (unbranded Cyltezo), or those who are established on Stelara to biosimilars of Pyzchiva (ustekinumab-ttwe) or Steqeyma (ustekinumab-stba) starting on and after 11/01/2025. - We are preparing for our **2025 HEDIS Hybrid Project** that will run **from January 2026 to April 2026**. **Your office may be contacted** during this timeframe **for records with dates of service in 2025 and prior** that were not already captured by claims.
- Flu season is approaching, and vaccinations remain one of the most effective ways to protect patients and communities.
- RSV Season 2025-2026: Our pharmacy team has created a summary of RSV-related immunization updates and information on coverage under medical and pharmacy benefits for RSV vaccines and RSV monoclonal antibodies used for immunization.
- The Michigan Medicaid SPDL Formulary has been updated as of 8/1/2025. These changes include drugs that have been added, removed, or had utilization management restrictions adjusted for preferred and non-preferred medications
- The coverage of certain insulin syringes and pen needle products has changed as of 08/01/2025 for all members. Effective on 08/01/2025, insulin syringes and pen needles other than Embecta (formerly known as B.D.) branded products have been removed from the formulary.
- Coverage of OneTouch Diabetic Test Strips has changed as of 10/01/2025 for all members. Effective 10/01/2025, OneTouch Diabetic Test Strips have been removed from the formulary (list of covered medications). Starting on 10/01/2025, the preferred diabetic test strips and glucometers is Accu-Chek Guide Test Strips, along with Accu-Chek Guide and Guide Me branded glucometers. This applies under the pharmacy benefit for Michigan Meridian Medicaid members.
